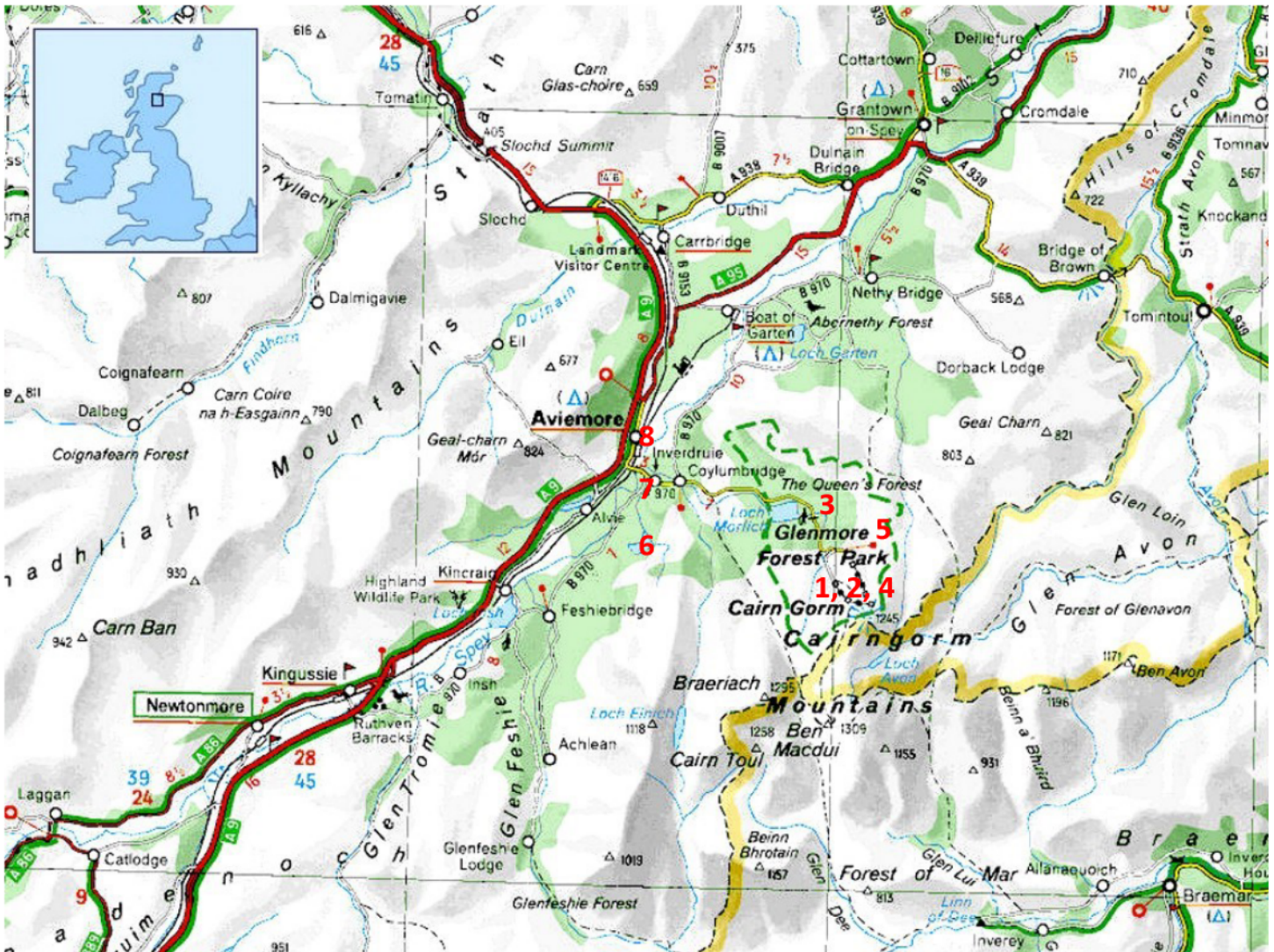




Aviemore

Cairngorm Mountain Funicular CairnGorm Mountain is Britain's 6th highest and your gateway to an ancient glacial landscape. No matter what the weather, the mountain will inspire you. The mountain railway is a safe and comfortable way for visitors of all ages and ability to enjoy a journey that takes you 3600 feet above sea level.



Cairngorm Mountain Garden Mountain wildlife is typically found in distinct zones from the valley floor to the high plateau. The wild mountain garden recreates these habitat zones on different terraces within the garden so visitors of all abilities and ages are able to experience the native plants and wild flowers in their natural environment.



Cairngorm Reindeer Centre Britain's only free-ranging herd of reindeer. These tame and friendly animals are a joy to all who come and see them. Here are currently around 150 reindeer in the herd, mostly ranging on the Cairngorm Mountain.



Camera Obscura at CairnGorm Mountain is open during the summer months with free entry and is a key feature of the mountain arts project, 'Reading a Landscape'. It stands at 2083 feet above sea level in its own distinctive black timber building at the top of the Mountain Garden close by the funicular railway track, a few metres' walk from the base station.



Glenmore Forest Park A haven for wildlife and outdoor enthusiasts alike, it's no surprise that Glenmore translates from the Gaelic as the 'big glen'. Glenmore provides opportunities for walking, cycling, orienteering, cross country skiing and bird-watching



Loch an Eilein (loch of the island) with its 13th century island castle was voted 'UK's best picnic spot', easy walks through ancient forest round the loch with views of the island castle and mountains. Visitor center, toilets, attended car park open every day.



Rothiemurchus Centre Relax, play and experience one of the 'Most Amazing places in the UK' 35+ outdoor activities in stunning surroundings, Loch an Eilein, Estate Farm Shop, Restaurant, Cafe, unusual Gifts and Cards.



Strathspey Steam Railway celebrating 40 years of vintage rail travel from Aviemore, the line travels 10 miles along the Spey Valley through Boat of Garten to Broomhill with spectacular photo opportunities.
