Day 1:

In the city's renovated dockyards, the Titanic Quarter includes the Titanic Belfast museum, an aluminium-clad edifice reminiscent of a ship's hull, shipbuilder Harland and Wolff's drawing offices and the Titanic slipways, which now host open-air concerts.

Our great city blossomed from very humble beginnings... It started out as a small hamlet with fertile land along the mouth of the Lagan. Soon, it was realized our lough was deep and our shores were safe from the north Atlantic storms. The perfect haven for repairing sea ravaged ships.
